



THE COA WAY CODE OF CONDUCT

1

Coaches must dress appropriately and professionally during all activities inside and outside the event.

2

Coaches are required to be in attendance for each team and are responsible for the behavior of their Athletes, parents, and support staff. These individuals are a representation of your organization. Suppose any representative/participant of your group causes a disturbance during or after the event or disrespects event staff. In that case, your team(s) will be ejected and disqualified from future The COA Way events.

Athletes must always be in a t-shirt, tank, or jacket showcasing their team's name. If the athlete's uniform/costume showcases the team name, the athlete may wear their uniform/costume.

4

Parents of Athletes must exhibit positive sportsmanship during all The COA Way events. Failure to do so will result in ejection from the event.

5

Coaches are not allowed to antagonize or make negative contact with the crowd or other team Athletes/Coaches. Coaches that engage in malicious or negative behavior will have their team ejected from the event.

6

All attendees, coaches, and participants must show respect towards all Athletes of other teams, respect all rules, and showcase great sportsmanship during the entire event.

7

Coaches/Parents must always chaperone their Athletes while maneuvering through the event. Athletes shall never be unsupervised throughout the event.

8

Any team this is dismissed from the event for any reason will receive NO REFUND on any monies paid for participation.

9

Teams will be assessed a penalty, including disqualification or ejection from an event for misconduct by an athlete, coach, or attendee.

** A Coaches meeting will be held to reiterate all of the above. Coaches will be required to sign an acknowledgment of their responsibility for their parents, staff, and Athletes, as well as the consequences for misconduct.**
